

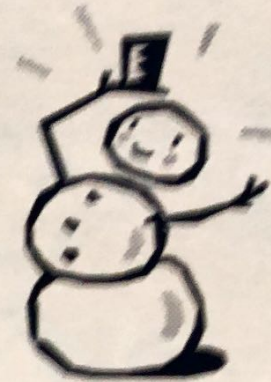
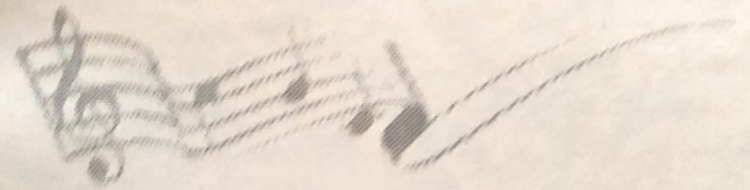
The Rutgers Alma Mater
